Staff Packing List

Very Important for International Staff

Passport with Visa and DS-2019 (International)
Money in USD
Insurance card/ID that was created by your agency (International)
Drivers License
Phone and Charger
Power Converter
Any prescribed Medication you take*

*No medication is allowed to be stored in the bunk with the exception of birth control and inhalers. Before campers arrive, any medication should be given to the infirm to dispense. Lockers are also available.

Every Day Items:

Plan for 10 days worth of clothes

Jumpers/Sweatshirts/Sweaters
Long pants/sweat pants/Jeans/Leggings
Bathing Suits*
NO TOWELS - Full Towel Service Provided at camp.

T shirts/Tank tops
Underwear
Socks
Rain Jacket
Trainers/Sneakers/Athletic shoes
PJs/Onesies
Toiletries
Sunscreen
Special Clothes - (Bring whatever you will need for the speciality you are working in, e.g. Horseback riding, soccer etc.)
Shower Caddy
Flash light/torch

*Bathing suits must be appropriate. Female staff should have at least one, one piece bathing suit.
Waterfront staff should plan to have at least 4 suits.

Other Suggestions

If available bring some green & White clothes, socks, hats etc, you may want them for color war.
Onesies are great and come in handy on cold nights

Girls camp does lots of theme days. You may want to bring some neon colors and any crazy clothes you have.

Bring a flag or shirt or something that represents your country

Linens are provided for international staff, i.e pillow cases, sheets, blankets and towels.
